Wisdom: lit. "skilled living"

Proverbs 26:12

"Wisdom <u>shouts</u> in the streets. She cries out in the public square."

How do I get wisdom?

1. Embrace correction

"To learn, you must love <u>discipline</u>; it is stupid to hate <u>correction</u>." Proverbs 12:1

"The instruction of the wise is like a <u>life</u> giving fountain." Proverbs 13:14

"If you listen to constructive criticism, you will be at home among the wise." Proverbs 15:31

Condemnation: wants to push you <u>away</u> and push you <u>lower</u> Correction: pull you <u>towards</u> and push you <u>higher</u>
