2. The six days are for dancing to the right rhythm.

3. The six days are for diligence: Vocationally & Relationally.

"Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain."

[Proverbs 6:6]

4. The six days are warfare.

"Unless the Lord guards the house the watchmen stay awake in vain."
[Psalm 127:1]
