### 1. Without purpose you'll find problems.

### 2. Expect temptation.

Temptation: the presentation & opportunity to sin.

"He sent someone to find out who she was, and he was told, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite."

[2 Samuel 11:3]

"Then David sent messengers to get her; and when she came to the palace, he slept with her."

3. Never say never.

5. Grace > Sin

Grace: goes for conviction, not condemnation.
